



## Hull Schools' Library Service Core Offer: Primary and Secondary Schools 2023-2024

*Please note, services and commitments are subject to changes made at a national and local level due to COVID-19. All resources are offered on a first-come, first-served basis, and subject to availability.*

Service	Description	Entitlement
<b>Annual Book Loan</b>	2 books per child on roll, a mixture of fiction and non-fiction.	Dependent upon pupil numbers
<b>Stock Rotation</b>	Rotate your annual loan selection so the children always have something new to read or to complement your creative curriculum	When required
<b>Library set-up/revamp</b>	Set-up of a school library/library spaces, or reinvigoration of current areas. We offer assistance when planning library spaces, giving advice regarding suitable furniture and where to purchase from.	2 days per year. Should longer be required, a librarian rate will be charged (see below)
<b>Book Corner revamp/creation</b> <b>NEW!</b>	Complete audit of all stock across all classrooms. Redistribution of books to ensure age-appropriate titles are accessible in each classroom and demonstrate progression across the school. High quality texts delivered and book areas revamped to meet OFSTED requirements.	1 day per year. Should longer be required, a librarian rate will be charged (see below)
<b>Class Reads</b>	Set of 30 texts	1 box per class per term
<b>Resource Boxes</b>	A box full of artefacts and other kinaesthetic resources to support topic-based, enquiry learning.	1 box per year group per term
<b>Topic Book Boxes</b>	A set of 30 texts, selected to the topics you choose	1 box per class per term
<b>Story Sacks</b>	Contains a favourite children's book and supporting materials (e.g. toys, puppets, games etc) to make reading meaningful and fun	1 per class per term
<b>Science Experiment Kits</b>	Contains enough resources for a full class to do a range of experiments, matched to popular curriculum science topics, e.g. <i>Everyday Materials</i> , <i>Changing Circuits</i> , <i>Changing Materials etc</i>	1 box per year group per term
<b>Sensory Story Boxes</b>	Each box contains a specially written story and carefully selected resources to use with children, helping them to understand and experience the events within the story.	1 box per year group per term
<b>NEW! Book Club in a Bag</b>	Everything you need to run a book club...in a bag!	When required
<b>Storytime Sessions*</b>	Fun and exciting storytime sessions with a trained Literacy Engagement Officer	1 per year group per year
<b>Author Visits*</b>	A captivating author visit to enthuse the children about reading	1 visit per year
<b>Library Visits</b>	Visit your local library to find out what is really on offer!	1 librarian-supported visit per class per year
<b>Librarian Assemblies*</b>	An assembly aimed at different key stages to show the children what is on offer at their local libraries.	1 per key stage per year



<b>Library Skills lessons*</b>	A training session for pupils to enable them to use the library effectively and help you keep it organised.	Every class
