When I get to the library I will see a desk.




I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.

In the library there will be shelves of books, CDs and DVDs.

The staff will scan the book, CD or DVD and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



The library will also have some computers.



The computers are free to use.
